

Different Types of AAC Devices

☀️ No-Tech or Light-Tech ☀️



No-tech or light-tech AAC requires no use of battery operated devices. This would be something such as a communication board, letter board, or use of a pen and paper to write/draw a message.

☀️ Mid-Tech ☀️

Mid-tech AAC devices are battery-operated, and can provide some speech generated output. An example of a mid-tech option would be a Big Mac button that plays single, or multiple pre-recorded speech messages.



☀️ High-Tech ☀️

High-tech AAC devices are robust electronic systems that are either dedicated, or non-dedicated. Dedicated devices are those which are only used for speech generating purposes. Non-dedicated devices are those which you can download an application onto for speech generating purposes, but can still use for other means.
